Jumbo white clover is a perennial legume suited primarily for pasture, but can be used for high quality hay and silage. White clovers are important pasture legumes in most temperate regions of the world. Jumbo is winter hardy like other clover varieties and does well on soils that are slightly acidic and poor to drain. Jumbo is both palatable and nutritious. It is very suitable for overseeding pastures.

Jumbo, like other clovers, requires a firm seed bed for good uniform germination. It can be combined with orchardgrass, bluegrass or tall fescues for use in different grazing systems or for soil/erosion applications. Plant in the fall for Southern users and in the spring for Northern applications. Strong clover stands will help minimize the need for nitrogen fertilization due to its ability to fix atmospheric nitrogen.
